Car parking, toilets and refreshments are close to the start and finishing point. Turn down Stubbins Hall Lane off B194 Crooked Mile (signed Lee Valley Park Farms; River Lee Country Park), then bear left between metal posts, continue past first car park and toilets on right, to reach Fishers Green overflow car park. The walk will be marshalled by Rotarians, who will also be at the start to give walk directions and collect sponsorship details and funds already obtained.

Do bring sensible footwear. Drivers approaching car parks and parking up should be particularly aware of pedestrians, especially children. Walkers should take care if close to the water's edge. Children under 14 must be accompanied by an adult. The paths are suitable for pushchairs.
